We will use practical and visual methods, and engaging resources to bring our learning to life.

The key focus is on developing greater-depth in the areas of:

- phoneme recognition (e.g. knowing that the letter 'a' is sounded out as 'ah')
- grapheme correspondence (the way of writing down a phoneme)
- I, 2, 3 and 4-letter sounds/graphemes (r, ch, igh)
- 'tricky' words that do not follow usual phoneme rules e.g. 'the'
- sentence reading

We will use the Read, Write, Inc order of teaching phonics, based on sets I, 2 and 3. You can find more information about the <u>programme here</u>.
