I. How do I book onto a course?

Simply send an email or complete the booking enquiry form. I will then be in contact to organise a place for your child on your chosen course.

2. Will my child miss out on the learning if they can't attend a lesson?

If your child can't make the in-person or live online lesson that week there is no need to worry. Recorded versions of the courses are provided each week for students to catch up on their own time.

3. What platform do you use for the online live lessons?

All live lessons are delivered via Zoom.

4. What resources will we need for the courses?

This would depend on the course, and full details are shared ahead of the course commencing. II+ courses require the purchase of a small number of CGP books. Other courses are based on my own resources. These are uploaded ahead of time and downloadable via my student management system.

5. Will there be homework for my child to complete?

Homework requirements are different, dependent on your chosen course. Full details are shared once you are booked onto a course. II+ courses require regular, independent homework to be completed. Other courses provide optional activities that students can complete independently if they wish to.

6. Are there lessons in the school holidays?

Recorded lessons are provided for some weekly courses in the school holidays. Full details of the dates and frequency of courses are provided in the course brochures. Notifications of breaks for holidays, or recorded lessons during the holidays, are sent out to parents ahead of time.

7. How do I pay for the courses?

An initial deposit of £50 is paid upon booking to secure your child's place on the course. This is refundable against the first monthly/half-termly payment. Specific payment frequencies are included in each of the course brochures. Invoices are sent via email after each payment period, payable by BACS.
